Applicants must have a registered nurse (RN) license in the United States or its territories that is current, active, and in good standing through the start date of their intended program and a conferred Associates in Nursing (ASN) that includes an Anatomy & Physiology course

Early Conditional Admission Option: BSN or BSN-AIM

Students currently enrolled in their last term of or completed within the last 6 months an accredited Associate's Degree of Nursing program may apply for early conditional admission to the BSN, BSN-AIM programs. Students who are admitted conditionally will need to provide and satisfy the following prior to their 2nd term of enrollment:

- 1. Documented proof of an active registered nurse (RN) license in the United States or its territories.
- 2. All other admission requirements for the BSN or BSN-AIM are satisfied prior to their desired start date.

Until the information is received, a hold will prevent the student from registering for classes beyond the first period of enrollment.
