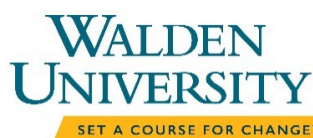

Walden University accepts **up to 135 quarter credits** (90 semester credits) in transfer to this program. One semester credit equals 1.5 quarter credits. **Quarter credit equivalencies are shown.**

A **minimum of 45 quarter credits** (30 semester credits) must be earned at Walden. The above is recommended as a mapping tool. Mapping is based on the current catalog and subject to change. Official transcripts required. Transfer acceptance subject to registrar approval.
